#### Practical Halacha - the three weeks

#### Haircuts

- Haircuts are not allowed for men or for women;
- Shaving and trimming beards is not allowed;
- Electrolysis, waxing, etc. is allowed (for women!);
- If you will incur a loss, shaving/haircuts are allowed until the week of Tisha b'av;
- A mustache that prevents you from eating may be cut even during the week of Tisha b'av;
- Wigs can be cut if necessary;
- Nails can be cut up until the week of Tisha b'av;
- If Tisha b'av falls out on Shabbos then nails can be cut on Erev Shabbos.

#### Music

- No music or dancing even at a seudas mitzva. Singing is fine;
- Music on tape etc. is not allowed;
- Music lessons are permitted;
- If necessary, slow inspirational or classical music is fine;
- Music for exercise is allowed;
- Music to keep you up while you drive is allowed;

#### Shechayanu (clothing)

- It is preferable not to make shehecheyanu at all;
- This means we should not eat or buy new fruits because of the shechayanu;
- shehecheyanu on Shabbos is allowed;
- Today many do not make shehecheyanu on clothes;
- Clothing that is not visible (underwear) can be bought and worn;
- Clothing can be bought in order to be worn after the three weeks;
- Large purchases are allowed but if they make you happy then you shouldn't buy them;

#### Construction

- Construction shouldn't be done during the nine days and it's better not to be done at all during the three weeks;
- If it was started before the three weeks then it can be finished;
- No moving into a new house, unless you have no place else to live;
- Going to contract on a house is allowed.


